The best thing to do would be to view the course listings for any particular semester at - <http://busi.binghamton.edu/>.

In the "Schedule of Classes" under SSIE & Industrial Engineering, you can find out which Professor is going to offer what course.

Then go to the Professors website under <http://ssie.binghamton.edu/faculty.html> and look for the suggested texts for that course.

You might want to write to the professors whose courses you are planning to take to make sure you get what they want. Professors may want the latest editions.

People use old editions too, but see what the professors have to say.

Like for instance, SSIE 505-Applied Probability and Statistics by J.L.Devore - 6th Edition. I cannot tell you for sure if there is a 7th edition now and if Professor Khasawanneh intends to use that for the course in Fall 2006. We used that Edition (6th). It might not be the same case for you people. Please confirm. Please do not ask the professors what textbooks are required, they will tell you to find it on the website! Just confirm the details with them.

All the required texts are mentioned on the website if you do a little research. If not, we can help you out with it.
