I got my VISA at Chennai consulate on July 8th

(10.00 a.m)....The Most eventful moment in my life...I received VISA Yesterday morning delivered at my house..I owe this success fully to each and every group member...especially I would like to thank the members Bran,Ashwin,Aditya,MS consultancy,Kapil,Pandit abishek....and so many others who reply caringly to each and every question put up in this group.I also would like to thank Mr.Suresh @ IMS institute and Mr.Palani @ Visu consultancy.who have guided me for the VISA prep & interview...

INITIAL PREPARATION:

1.BOOKING A SLOT:

If U try continuously u would surely get a slot no doubt in it...I tried for 15 continuous long hours and I got this slot very narrowly on July 8th(My first slot was on Aug 25th)....So I would say the members if u need a slot u need to sit before the pc and have to keep on refreshing the calendar page...I would say u could open some five windows of the link of the calendar And continuously refresh each and every window side by side...and surely u r to get a date...I got the date thro the same procedure and I got it in a fraction.....So friends who r yet to get a date...keep on trying....

2.DOCUMENTATION:

Keep all the documents Perfect..(Better not to go for false documentation).The very essential documents are.

1. All Semester Marksheets in your Undergraduation
2. Degree certificate(if u've received)or else Provisional certificate.
- 3.10th and 12th certificate(In chennai consulate they did not ask for this but it is safer if U carry it with u).
- 4.GRE & TOEFL score sheets.
- 5.CA statement ,
6. All bank passbooks.
- 7.Family IT returns
- 8.Affidavit of Support(Not required if parents are the sponsor but its better u carry it along).
- 9.Valuation certificate of house and house documents etc...
10. LIC,P.F. statement ,Valuation certificate of car and Jewellery(not particularly necessary) and also any documents relating to ur car(RC book),....

These are the most essential documents needed....U could also carry your professional honors such as gold medal or any other certificate...U can also type a resume if u need.

3.ARRANGEMENT OF DOCUMENTS:

I arranged my documents in the harmonium file(This file has got a lot of individual pouches with a flag over each of it...U can place a set in any of the separation and also write it in the flag over each separation they give along with the file) I arranged my documents in this order.U can choose ur own order.

1st pouch:

Passport,3 DDs, Web appointment,DS forms, Admit letter, I-20, All marksheets and ur Score sheets(GRE & TOEFL),.

2nd pouch:

CA statement and all banks pass books

3rd pouch:

Affidavit of support and F.D. maturity documents.

4th pouch:

Salary Income Certificate, Family IT returns and Form 16.

5th pouch:

P.F,LIC,Jewellery valuation,car valuation and RC book.

6th pouch:

Other admit , I-20,Correspondence mails from the professors or from university and my project certificate.

7th Pouch:

Prospectus of the Univesity or any corresponding webpage printouts of the university say about the research in the university , about the faculty member's projects etc.

8th pouch:

SOP given to this particular university,Resume,Final year project abstract.

9th pouch:

Photo copies of ur marksheets and any other very important documents(Not needed if only u want to be extra cautious).

10th pouch:

Extra copies of Ds form, photographs, Fevi stick ,Pen,White paper,Pen and few clips.

SOME TIPS :

1.Take ur photograph with a white background and don't forget to remove borders around it(Normally in Studios they know this rule for VISA photograph but some people may forget., so better check it).

? DS forms filled properly(write Nil or None in the which is not applicable for you. Don't leave any space blank)..Type your DS form and take print out as soon as you do as you cannot save your file in normal Acrobat reader...Typed DS forms give a neat appearance and it is the DS form that's going to be your first impression...

?Write the period of stay.(Qn.no 26 in Ds-156) to be 24 months even though its mentioned 36 months in your I-20 if you are going for your Master's.

? If you are a fresher, write your undergraduate institution name and address for Qn.no.20

?When filling your e-mail address its better to give the i.d you gave for web appointment.

?For Purpose of your trip (qn.no.27), Do fill as “To pursue Master’s in ABC in XYZ university.”

?In one of my friend’s web appointment, I saw that it was mentioned... .DS- 157(for all applicants), so Gals..look into your Web appointment and carry DS-157 filled along with you...Better have it with you even though it is not mentioned in your web appointment...No harm in having an extra form filled with you....and Submit it if they ask you there.

3.Keep your primary documents arranged in this order...Web appointment,Passport,DS forms,Admit letter,I-20 and all your Marksheets and score cards...

If you’ve got good Academics than your GRE-TOEFL,Place it at the top and then arrange your score cards(if u’ve got a TOEFL better than GRE, place it at the top).

4.Memorize your C.A. statement...Better know the dollar values, so that you could reduce a little strain for the V.O. to convert from rupees to dollars.(If they ask how much salary do you expect on return say this in Rupees).

5.?Have Good knowledge about the university infrastructure i.e about the lab, library etc...

?Go through your faculties’s webpage and have an idea bout their research and areas of interest...Match some of the research there with the research going in some companies here in India.

?Memorize some faculties name and also the courses in your program.

6.Go through all the Messages daily for atleast 3 hours in the all groups for VISA and fall-2003.

INTIAL PROCEDURE AT THE CONSULATE:

1.First they check in your web appointment and passport outside the consulate and let you in..It is enough if you come there ½ an hour before...But if u r lucky enough u can get in b’fore that...My slot was 9.00- 9.15 a.m but I was let in by 8.20 a.m as all the fellows behind were nearly of my slot.

2.They ask if u’ve got any electronic equipments such as cell phone....They scan your file using a machine...

3.Now u’ve got to stand in a queue , show ur web appointment and passport and pay Rs.300 dd for the TTS people.

4.After paying it, u’ve got to stand in a Queue titled Cashier and Pay your Rs.4900 D.D, She’ll also check your Rs.3675 D.D and passport; She’ll now give you a pink slip with your token number and a yellow and white slip.

5.You’ll see other five counters and you ‘ve to stand in this queue in any of the counters and give your web appointment,passport,DS forms,Marksheets,Score cards, white and pink slip.

6.They’ll arrange these documents in a separate file and will give back a part of the pink slip to you and will ask you to go to the main room where in u r to be interviewed...

7.You’ll reach an Ac room...U’ve to push the door hard by pressing the handle in order to open it.U can go have water, snacks here...and take a comfortable seat inside the room..When a set of file comes to the V.O, he/ she calls the attender Deva, Who will make us stand in a queue starting from a white line drawn there...The V.O will signal each and every one to come there...

SOME TIPS:

1. Have your SEVIS registration checked with your university and take printout of the mail.
2. Be friendly to the people in the Indian counters, Say good morning...Thank you etc and if they delay by making you wait...Don't show Ur impatience outside...Be calm and wait till they ask you the documents.....these people are going to decide your VISA...if they are impressed by our behaviour and DS forms without mistake.....they can recommend it to the V.O by some indication.....the same can happen the reverse...if u r a bit harsh and DS forms with lot of mistakes.....they'll again indicate it to the V.O...So be amiable to these persons.

I saw a guy, who was a bit harsh 's DS form being marked with a highlighter by the person in the Indian counter and unfortunately I also saw him got his VISA rejected...So please be polite to these Indian people....

3. After you enter the main venue...standing in the queue.....Wait till the person before you gets off from the counter...Wait till the V.O. signals you to come...Patience is very essential here....
4. Greet the V.O and make him/her impressed with your first answer....

MY VISA INTERVIEW:

I had my visa interview for some 30 to 40 seconds(I think so)..Anyhow before that...I entered the AC hall by 9.40 a.m...I saw two counters for F1- Visa(3&4) open...counter 2 was closed...Counter 1 is the place where you go when your VISA is sanctioned...I don't have any idea about the other 3 counters...I was a bit relieved as I saw the bald headed V.O and a bit middle aged lady V.O in the 3rd and 4th counters...they both were showering F1s to all the people who came to them...I was thinking of that the brunette lady V.O...she was not there and I've heard she puts on long interview.....as soon as this thought flashed, the brunette V.O opened counter 2 and Deva made some 6 people to stand before her....I again thought I should not go here and should go to 3rd or 4th counter...and as soon as I thought this...Deva called my number and made me stand third in the queue before counter 2.....

I was a bit tensed but was very confident that I'll surely get my VISA...The only thought that was in my mind when I was in the queue was..."GOD PLEASE SAVE ME....I SHOULD AND I WILL GET MY VISA.....".I did not even rehearse my answer.....but I had lots and lots of confidence that I will get my VISA.....

The two people before me got rejected...and then it was me.....I waited till the V.O signaled me to come, even though the person before me left...The V.O was looking into her P.C. for some time and then signaled me to come....There...I was standing before her and gave a sheepish smile and she smiled back...

ME:Good morning mam....

V.O:Good Morning.....

V.O: Why U.S?

(Normally people gave answer as to do masters in so and so institution...look at my answer)..”

ME: In India there are lot of programmers but very few system architects..the reason is they don't have a proper masters...I don't just want to be a programmer, I want to be a system architect....U.S education is world class and I'm sure with a major there..I would be able to be placed as a system architect here and I could serve my nation....

V.O:(Impressed)That's a good answer...So whats your family's annual income?

ME: XXX dollars per annum...

(She was having the documents bundle in her hand...I've placed my Provisional certificate at the top as I've got good academics(79%)...My Toefl(243 6.0 in essay) then and at last My GRE(1120/1600 4.0 in essay))

ME:(Even before she asked anything...I said)Mam,I've got good academics and I have first class with distinction..and I've a good position in my class.

V.O:(Looked into my eyes and said..) Ok.good

(Mean time she wrote F1 and placed on the tray before...but I could not understand that I got my VISA 'nd I was standing before her expecting a question).

V.O: What will u do after M.S?

ME: Come back here and join in any of the MNCs

V.O:What r ur parents?

ME: My mothers an university professor and HOD...shes a doctorate and my dad was a head master for 37 years(he got retired last year...before I tried saying she nodded yes)..

ME: Please look into my pass book mam...We've got xxx dollars as savings....

V.O: No I don't want to..You've got ur VISA....

(With atmost stupidity stood there not understanding what she said).

V.O:(with a broad smile) Have U got any cousin?

ME:Pardon....I don't get u mam.

V.O:Do u have any cousin....

ME:(Still I couldn't get her properly as I dunno why she asked abt my cousin...she should've come across some person being so stupid like me standing before her even after getting VISA)...I said no and to add to the scene..I said I've got only one sis and she's married...

V.O:(She again gave a broad smile and asked me to pay my fees at counter1.)

ME:(Atlast I understood that I've got my VISA)....Thank you mam....

V.O:(Again she gave a smile).

(Not a single document checked I collected my marksheets and went to counter 1)
I paid my fees and stepped outside the consulate at about 10.05. a.m...

All the V.Os are pretty lenient and kind...they test your confidence and try to find out if you are genuine student....that's it.....So..STAY COOL...Carry lots of confidence and prayers...the VISA is yours.....

SOME TIPS:

1.I've got a poor verbal...though I took my GRE twice I could'nt improve...I was worried a lot if the V.O will question me...but she did not even look at my score cards..the reason is I've placed my Provisional at the top as I've got good academics

and as soon as she took that bundle...I came out with my academic record...and she did not look at my score cards below that...That's it....

2. Answer ur first question very well..that gives a good impression..See I did not get a long interview because My first answer satisfied the V.O...

3.If they ask for income or abt fees answer it without hesitation

4.Answer with a cool, confident and loud voice..

5.Look into the V.Os eyes when answering.

6.Have water and use the toilet if necessary before the interview....

7.Dress neatly...comb up ur hair properly.....

8.Have a good sleep the previous night.

9.Have your bath and don't forget to have ur breakfast or lunch on the day of your interview....

10.Above all Pray god...that solves lot of your problems.....Hes the one who will give u the VISA.....

If u've got any doubts do mail me.....

Some Model Q & A for MBA's

Possible Visa Q and A

1 > Why do u want to go to US ?

To do Masters in Business Administration

2 > Why do you want a degree from US ?

US is way *ahead in managerial development* as compared to other countries of the world. US B-Schools offers *new and advanced courses* like Information Technology Management, Entrepreneurship, etc and there is a lot of flexibility in these courses, which is absent in Indian Universities. Moreover US B- Schools *stress on practical knowledge* & not just book learning. (Don't keep your answer very long. Just remember the points. The points are in bold italics in my case.)

3 > Why Don't you study in India ?

(This is the same question as the second but you can answer it in a different way. Any 1 q will be asked. If 2nd q is asked, stress on + points of US schools and if why not India is asked, show the negative side of Indian Universities. In both the cases you have to show the plus points of US Universities with compared to Indian Universities)

Masters Education in India lays *more emphasis on the theory part* rather than the practical, Hence a Masters degree from India does not really help in fulfilling the career goals of a person. Indian Universities *don't have enough research facilities* to support students in their studies, whereas US Universities have sound infrastructure to support students to gain both the theoretical as well as practical knowledge. Moreover, the *courses in India are not flexible as in US*.

4 > What is your GMAT/TOEFL score ?

My GMAT score is 560 and TOEFL score is 250.

5 > Why your verbal score is so low in GMAT ?

I *answered the first few questions incorrectly* and I couldn't improve my score later even after performing well later. But you can see that the *TOEFL score is decent* which shows my proficiency in the English language.

6 > How many Applications ? Acceptance ? Rejects ?

I have applied in 4 universities. Got admit in 1, reject in 1 and the rest are awaiting.

7 > Do you intend to come back ? or

What if you are offered a job in US ?

Yes! I have *family and economic ties* to India. I have an established family business, which is more than 60 years old. (pheeeko) I am going to US to upgrade my skills and knowledge in Business which will give confidence when I come back to India and join my fathers business.

8 > What if I reject you ?

I have tried my best to fulfill all the requirements to get a visa. With the kind of academic and financial background that I have, I never thought that such a question would ever arise.

9 > Why should I allow you a visa ?

(here if q8 is asked, don't expect q9 to be asked as it is one and the same q)

I have tried my best to fulfill all the requirements to get a visa. I have a strong educational and financial background and a genuine reason to go to US. So, I expect a visa from you.

10 > Why do you want to do MBA ?

There will be *greater need for the managerial expert* in our expanding business firm. The MBA program will provide me with an *advanced preparation in management*, enabling me to participate as educated professional in society and the business environment and compete in a dynamic global economy.

11 > Why this University ?

(Do some research over the University and the courses offered there. Here you can also mention about the research work of your interest undertaken by some Professor. Name the professor.)

The first and foremost factor for selecting this university were the *courses* being offered, I also *contacted the seniors* there to know more about the university and got a very positive reply from them. The course is designed in such a way that it develops knowledge of the functions and techniques of management and blends an understanding of social, technological, economic and political environment into the core of the program.

12 > What are the courses offered ? or

What type of courses are there ?

The different type of courses are economic concept in management, accounting, operation analysis, financial strategy, marketing strategy, entrepreneurship.

13 > How did you come to know about your University ?

I came to know about the University from Graduate School Magazine of USEFI, internet and email exchanges with the seniors.

14 > What do you know about the University ?

The University is located in south-east of Massachusetts, one hour driving distance from Boston and 35 minutes from Providence. The University is surrounded by small towns like New Bedford and Fall River. The University offers around 60 courses to graduates and undergraduates and there are more than 320 full time faculties. There are more than 7000 students in the University.

15 > Supposing you meet someone in the US whom you like, would you consider marrying her ?

I am from a *traditional family*. I am very much *concerned about my career* and definite on my goals. I have more *important responsibilities to shoulder* and am confident not to get carried away or get attracted to people. I have decided to do an MBA and am very professional and business minded.

16 > Do you plan to work in the US...supposing on-campus ?

I have *no* plans to work while studying. I want to complete the course as early as possible and come back and join my dads business.

17 > Who is sponsoring you ?

My parents.

18 > How many members in a family ?

Six.

19 > What does your parents do ?

My father is a Wholesaler in textile business. My mother works part-time in this business. (be specific)

20 > Any siblings ? What are they doing ?

I have two elder brothers. My eldest brother is a Chartered Accountant and has his own practice whereas my second brother is studying. (I have mentioned in 156 form that my elder brother is in US on F-1 visa, but do not mention to the interviewer unless specifically asked. Else expect some more questions.)

21 > How will your parents bear the expenses of you and your brother ?

My brother has got the tuition waiver and scholarship from the University. I have a photocopy of his I-20 issued last year stating the same. And after reaching US, he got teaching and research assistantship because of which he is able to meet

all his expenses and my parents need not send him money any more. The fund in the bank is entirely for my educational expenses.

22 > Why the entries in the passbook are recent ?

My father is doing business since last 30 years and has been saving since last several years for my higher studies. He lent these savings to close friends and relatives to earn interest. Now that the time has come for my studies, we have taken this money back from them. (Different ppl have different answers here. Lie confidently in this answer)

23 > What is your parents annual income ?

My family's annual income is _____

24 > Even in this condition of economic recession, you want to go US. Why ?

I am going there for studies and I want to return back after my studies. So, economic recession in US doesn't affect me.

25 > What was your first choice ?

My first choice was University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth. (try to show that the University you got admit from was your first choice, but it doesn't matter even if it is not.)

26 > Why not UIC. It is ranked higher than this ?

Unlike other Universities, University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth offers new and advanced courses like Information technology management, entrepreneurship etc. Besides this, the University has a Business Development center where the students and faculties together do the research work and provides the counseling services to prospective and existing businesses.

27 > Name some professors of your University ?

(add prefix 'Dr' to the professor even if he is not of doctorate level)

Dr. Omar Khalil, Dr. Avijit Gangopadhyay

28 > Why have you not applied to _____ university even though you have sent your GMAT score ?

I had done an extensive research over the Universities before applying to any university. I tried to match my requirements with the University's requirement. Some how some things were not matching. So I did not apply to that University. (Visa ppl may ask you abt the things not matching and u may tell abt the research or courses not offered in this university.)

Experience 1:

Amit's profile: GRE-2030 TOEFL-617 University : Virginia Tech Stream-IE

Interviewer: please show me your I20.

(amit produces his I20)

Interviewer : what's your GRE score.

Amit: 2030

Inter.: Can I have look at your score sheet please.

(amit submits his GRE score sheet)

Interwiever: You seem to have a good GRE score.

Amit: Thankyou Sir

(Comments- actually amit was quite puzzled as to how the interviewer mentioned as his score to be high. But the matter of fact is that these people usually look at the verbal scores and amit had a high verbal score of 680.)

Interviewer : Which univ are you going to ?

Amit: Virginia tech .

interviewer: that's a very tough school. Why did you choose such a tough school?

Amit: Sir , the specialization which I want to pursue in IE is facilities design. and Virginia Tech is supposed to be one of the best schools for this specialization. That's the reason I chose this school.

(comments-One should never just say that the school is high ranked rather you should try and reply the way amit did ie talk more about the course specialization and don't forget to talk some techie stuff so that the interviewer gets the message that you know what you are going to do.)

Inter.:Do you have any financial support from the university?

Amit: No sir.

(Comment: always be straight forward about your aid status. Don't say that I will get once I go to the university....etc etc.. remember this will always work against you.)

Inter.: Who's your sponsor?

Amit: my parents

Inter.: Do you have any supporting financial documents?

Amit: Yes Sir.

(amit now forwards his CA statement.)

Inter.: Do have anything more concrete than this?

Amit now forwards his bank statement

the interviewer has a look at it and gives it back to him

Interviewer: All the best son. Study well!

Amit was asked to pay his visa fee. which meant that he had got his visa.

EXPERIENCE 2

10) What is ur car no ?? (i told him my bike no...u shud tell the answer immediately...if u delay he will understand that we are lying)

Experience 3:

VO: How do you plan to finance ur education.. 17K \$ is a lot of money
ME: Yes Sir, My parents are sponsoring
VO: UR parents annual income is only 5L .. how can they sponsor u (this is the trick question.. u get flustered here.. ur done)
ME: Yes Sir, its 5L.. they have saving of ...L and I am taking a bank loan of 12L (this was more then required.. my total savings and bank loan was about 1.5 times that required for 2 yrs))
VO: So what will be ur repayment per month
ME: around 20thousand per month
VO: (sounds very surprised and says).. thats a lot of money... how can you repay (he stares at me.. like i am some criminal)
ME: (with the same tone that he used..) 20 thousand is not at all a lot of money.. i am very sure of repaying it back. .it shouldnt be a problem at all
VO: Gives me a proper stare...looks right into my eyes
ME: Give him a smile
VO: Go pay ur fees.. i am on seventh heaven

1] Dont put all your documents in the folder given by the tts people bcoz that we will be giving it to counsellor he will not see the docs completely. This was the problem faced by me. if i would have kept some of my financial docs with me i would have shown him as soon as he asked me.

2] He [counsellor] asked me about my dad's annual income i told him he is earning about X lakhs per annum ... then he asked me that how much he will be providing you in that X lakhs.. i told him that he will be providing me X-1 lakhs for my education.

3] counsellor after seeing my I20 where it is mentioned my course duration as 3years including 1 year as grace . he kept hanging to it saying that my course duration is 3 years and u dont have sufficient funds to pay for it . i told him that only 2 years is the course duration and 1 year is grace he not even tried to listen my words. so any one going for counselling keep that in mind what to answer if this question is being posed to you.

Experience 5:

The interview was like this.

Con. Officer: Hiii!!! (with a broad smile)

Me: Hello sir (Smiling)

Gave him my folder.

CO: Louisiana State University.

Me: Yes sir.

CO: Why this univ?

Me: My area of interest is VLSI and advanced research work is going on over there in this area.

CO: Look, the annual expenses are 16,000 USD and ur course duration is 2.5 years as per ur i-20, it comes to 50,000 USD.

how will u meet these expenses?

Me: Sir, I am having a bank balance of 14.6 lacs and Fixed deposits of 2 lacs.

CO: what is your father?

Me: My father is ----- (told his occupation)

(In the certificate it was mentioned that the industry frequently needs expert technical advice, which they have to obtain from consultants, which costs them exorbitantly in terms of time and money. It was also mentioned that their industry would be greatly benefited if I get deep technical knowledge in advance countries like US) Right now, I am a BE and I am not in a position to provide the kind of expert advice they are looking for. In the mean time I got offer of teaching Math's. I like teaching profession and Math's has been my passion right from my school days. So I joined IMS.

Some suggestions

- a) Remember that they rely more on your words than the documents. Just say, whatever you want to, slowly and clearly. Speak confidently.
- b) If you take certificate from any industry, know something about

their industry

- c) If they ask for financial statement, always start with your strong point. For example take a case in which sponsor has annual income of 8 lakhs. This is obviously a strong point. Suppose he has bank balance but chunk of money is deposited only 15 days back. In such a case, first show the IT returns. High annual income should and would impress them and they may or may not ask for passbooks.
- d) You may say that you are the only child for your parents and that all the property is virtually yours.
- e) If your sponsor is a business man know something about his business like the products they manufacture, their annual turnover and so on
- f) Think of all sorts of questions that could be asked to you.

Prepare your answers and rehears the thing before you go for visa interview.

Experience 16:

Hello everyone, I got an F1 by gods grace from Chennai consulate. Going for MS in CS at UTD. My appointment was scheduled at 9:30 on Friday. Reached around 8:45. Arriving at the consulate early helps, as there is small queue outside it waiting to get in. it might help you in the end (if you are not fortunate enough to get a counter visa) i.e. during the agonizing wait for the interview. After initial security checks, they check your passport and your appointment letter outside, once you get in they see your file... that's it for security initially. Then you stand in another queue for paying the Rs 300 TTS charge. They will give you a file for inserting 2 drafts, I20, passport GRE, TOEFL. Everything will be marked and you are supposed to place them appropriately. You need to keep your mark sheets behind I20 as there is on separate provision for it. Then you are directed to another queue for paying the visa issuance fee. I paid around 9:20. You are supposed to write your name, address and passport number on the back of all drafts. On paying they issue a receipt and pink slip with the token number on it (I don't exactly remember where they issued it as I was having lots of paper

reg. financial details). After collecting this, they will ask you to sit for a while depending upon the queue at the next stage. You can arrange till the queue for the next counter gets cleared. This is where they issue counter visas. Our batch was fortunate enough and he didn't see my file/GRE score and returned the visa issuance draft to me. May be counter visas are temporarily suspended. He asked for degree certificates/provisional. I gave all the mark sheets I had and he returned the X, XII mark sheets back to me So only your BE/BTech mark sheets, provisional are required. He scans the photograph on your form and staples the pink slip to passport. So one photograph, which is on your form, is sufficient, though having additional photographs is no offence. He returned the passport and asked me to appear for the interview at the consulates office. There will be another security check point here and then you enter a well air-conditioned room. There are eight counters numbered. Counter 1 is where you pay the visa fee if granted.

I reached around 9:40 there only 3(4, 7, 8) counters are open initially. You will be seated and the guard will direct you to the next counter line that's free. After some time there were consuls...at 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8.

Mostly F1 were assigned to 2, 4, and 5. There were lots of rejects and I had hoped for a less number of rejections... but the consuls... at 4 was issuing visa without any problem after scrutiny of documents. I saw a lot of rejects from 5.

Luckily I got into counter 4. (There will be only three people in the line including the one interviewed. So you have to patiently wait for your turn)

the guy at 2 was also issuing visas as he came late. (Only one reject from his counter). When my turn came, this is what happened to me:

Me: Good morning Sir,

Coff: good morning (I slid the TTS cover to him, I kept the affidavit of support from the sponsor (on Rs. 20 stamp paper first). He saw that and within seconds returned it back to me, guess that's not necessary!

Coff: what do you know about Dallas?

Me: blaaaaaaaaaaaa

Coff: why do you want to do at UTD?

Me: blaaaaaaaaaaaa

(The file given by TTS has little space for our bulky financial papers so I kept the CA statement along with the bank statement of balance in SB, FD and other certificates I had got. He scanned them quickly. He saw the summary statement on the first page and asked me what my father was doing and also about my monthly income then he said the golden word while returning the students copy of I20... Which I dint her properly... there was some problem with his mike. So he repeated the golden words...

Coff: keep this for the aeroplane

Me: thank you sir

(He saw the CA statement and the bank certificates for FD, SB and retained my passport and I20 and returned the rest to me. He wrote F1 on the pink slip and asked me to pay the fee at #1 along with the visa issuance draft.

The passport reached me in a day. I got loan for 10 lakhs and I did not mention it in CA statement but I carried the sanction letter. He didn't ask anything at all regarding loan (regarding financial part I had shown 1 year fees in liquid 6.5 - SB, 7 - FD, 5 recent FD's obtained 2 weeks before interview. I got the money from relatives/others and transferred it onto FD's and SB.), some other TDs like post office worth 2, some shares

worth 20K, jewel sum for 4.85 lakhs, property around 18, annual income of 2.85) and the consulate enquired regarding my annual income in financial part. It's always better to show that your sponsor is working and getting a good salary (esp. sponsors who have got Voluntary Retirement's! an annual income of 3+ is certainly a good indication to the consulate regarding financial aspects. I saw the counter visa guy going to consulate office for

meeting them maybe they might have started issuing counter visas afterwards.

where your luck guides move to some counter and here is where you have to give your applications (156, 157, 158), i20, passport, all your transcripts, admission letter, gre, tofel scores and what ever he/ she asks. when finished he/she puts all the stuff in a file accordingly and gives you a token no & tells you to go for an interview in the next bldg.

step -3 final one

the nervousness starts here..... stay cool dont get panic! when you enter you see all the people being seated quietly. simply chose a place at the back side which is comfortable to u. i am saying backside bcos from there u can notice all the counters 1,2,3,4,5,6,7 clearly .

Him the TTS draft (for Rs 400) and he gave me another slip.

Was told by the guard to stand in line (I was the only one for a student visa!). There were a couple of people before me who got rejected for

student visas so I was a bit tensed.

Here is how it went

9:25 am.

Me: Morning

VO: (nothing, just kept entering something)

Me: (hand over my passport, I-20, DS forms, TTS slips)

VO: looks at them, asks for my GRE scores

Me: Hand over both my GRE and toefl scores.

VO: Which course do u plan on doing?

Me: MS in EE (DSP)

VO: Show me ure degree

Me: Hand it over

VO: What does ure dad do?

Me: Works as a GM etc.

VO: Ure scores are good and ure academic background is good, U'll get a Good job in America, why do u want to come back?

Me: Will start a factory etc.

Me and VO do some small talk on my family background/education scene in India etc. I think he kinda eased up to me.

VO: Sir, I do hope you'll come back to India. Give this to the TTS Counter guys.

Me: Yeah.....ok

Thats it. He didnt ask for anything. Bank Statement/ Salary slip

Didn't go to any visa counsellor. Just took some tips from USEFI. There is no need to get any CA statement/evaluations done.

That's it ppl. Apply early like me (cos there is no one and that's a good thing) and just be yourself. One word of Caution. At the Embassy in Delhi, u'll find lots of touts.

One tout (fat black guy) approached me and asked me to show my photograph to him. When I did he told me it was wrong and that my appointment will get cancelled. My photo was on an off white background and he said they wanted one on a white only background. He showed me one which was with a sparkling white background and kept telling me stuff like my visa will get rejected and my photo is 101% wrong. IT WASN'T. Believe me this is not what you want to hear 1/2 an hour before the interview. And frankly there is no way he could have got me a photo developed and processed in that time (which he said he could).

Don't listen to any touts, they'll just make you more tensed than you already are.

That's it, all the best to the rest.

I had my visa interview on 21st june at 8.30 am at the chennai consulate. I got a reject and would like to share this peculiar experience.

The visa official who interviewd me was the much dreaded Muslim Lady. The sequence of the interview is as follows:

I: Good Morning mam

she:nodded and mumbled checks my I-20 and wites and calculates something

She: very expensive?

I: I have funds for 2 years to cover my entire expenditure. Please verify the CA statement.

She: Do you have scholarship?

I:NO

She: Why?

I: This time OSU has awarded fellowships very stringently and only ppl with scores over 2300 have managed to get it.

She verifies my marksheets and I mention that I had govt acads of 91 % in the Madras University and will possibly get a good rank. she doesn't care.

She: What abt your dad?

I: Both my mom and dad are retired bank officials and we have more than sufficient savings to support my study and also an own house. You can verify with my financial statement and I have evidences for everything.

She: Any brothers / sisters?

I: No brothers, one younger sister who is doing final yr B.Com and trying for a Bank job.

She: Show your dad's passbook? (very sarcastically) I show it and she asks me where did this huge amt (4lacs) come from?

I: Explained how and show the proof

She waves it off and does not see my CA statement, any other financial documents.

She: I am sorry ma'am, I think you cannot support yourself in such a costly place. Please wait for a year, try to get scholarship from some cheaper university and then apply again. I tell her to please have a look at the Statement and that I can definitely manage without any problems.

She tells me: I am American and I think I know whether you can support yourself or not.

I: Thank you ma'am.

I was denied the F1 today by Nancy on the basis of 214(b) i.e. failing to convince the officer that I would come back to India after my studies. I am hoping to go for MSCS @ VTech.

She asked me a few general questions and everything went real smooth till the time she noticed my 2 employment passes on the PP for Singapore and one tourist visa for Malaysia.

She : So I see u were in SG for 2 years; What were you doing there ?

Me : Ma'am I was transferred by my current employer here to their SG branch for an assignment for 13 months. I came back last August.

She : And how do you explain the Malaysian visa ?

Me : Ma'am that was a tourist visa. I visited Malaysia for 5 days on a vacation from Singapore.

Then she just went and spoke to Cole I believe and came back after a minute.

She : Mr. Sukhija I'm sorry but I'm not sure you are going to come back, so I am gonna deny you the visa.

Me : Ma'am I can explain..

And as I was saying that, she already stamped and scribbled and handed over the docs back to me. I pleaded again, and she said I m sorry, I hv already made my decision. You will have to try again.

I couldn't believe that this was happening to me as all the while I was so sure that I was gonna get this visa today. I had all my documents done, answered firmly and confidently and I think I couldnt have done better than this.

I notice that nothing has been written on my PP or I-20. Just one stamp on the PP saying 'Applied for Visa on 27th June 2002'. There is absolutely no indication on what grounds was the visa rejected on the PP. Albeit there is one separate handout stating rejection clauses with 214(b) encircled.

Now I need your help friends, especially from those who have managed to get their visas on second attempts.

I need answers/suggestion on following points

- 1) Procedure for re-applying
- 2) Docs/Evidences/Ideas which can prove that I would come back.
- 3) Any tips/tricks for that matter.
- 4) Ppl say that u dont get the same interviewer again, how do they know who interviewed me last time when I go again now ? Shalaka ? Can u help ?

Background info:

I wrote in ds-156 that I am working as senior software engineer in a communication software firm.

Total pennState cost is \$26,201/year.

My pennS I-20 shows around ~ \$ 21000 against personal funds and ~ \$ 5201 against family funds. Total = \$26201.

(I have taken education loan of Rs 8.5 in my name. Plus i have Rs 2 lacs as my own savings.So that makes around \$ 21000 as my personal funds. Family funds = Rs 6 lacs ~ \$ 12000)

Consular: Who is going to fund ur study.

Me: Self and parents

Consular: r u are working

Me: yes sir for past 2 years

Consular: Can i see ur pay slip

I gave him my latest payslip. (It indicates my take home salary as Rs 25000 and gross:rs 34000..i haven't made any tax savings investments and have been paying full tax)

Consular: Are u married

Me: No sir

(In the meantime he was filling office space column of ds-156..)

Consular: Do u have any children

Me: No sir

Consular: Iam sorry i won't be able to issue u visa "today". US law doesn't allow students to work there.It is very "hard" these dayz to issue visas to people who haven't been to us or europe. U are taking home only Rs 20000. u don't seem to prove strong economic ties here.

Now i was totally confused..he had given me every reason in this world to reject my visa without seeing ANY other single document except visa appl., I-20 and my payslip !!!

I couldn't deduce at that moment that whether i had been rejected for:

- lacks of funds
- potential immigrant
- or sthg other..

(later i realized that he had taken me as an potential immigrant) then when i tried to explain him things..he simply refused to listen and said that "i have made my decision. have a good day" and threatened to call the guard if i insisted.

I was totally shaken by their indifferent attitude and lack of courtesy to atleast 'listen' to a person before making such a big decision.

Now i want to reapply (at delhi only). This time i intend to get a letter from Employer stating that they have plans for me when i come back.

It would be great if i can have info on:

- what time slots are given to second time applicants.
- and most importantly is it possible that i may end up facing the SAME guy again ???
